

ORDINANCE NO. 4-13 **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 84, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE X SPEED LIMITS, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF KINNELON**

WHEREAS, Chapter 84-27 of the Code of the Borough of Kinnelon ("Borough") currently establishes speed limits along certain streets in the Borough of Kinnelon; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to adopt a resolution to amend Chapter 84-27 to reduce the speed limit of Fayson Lakes Road between Boonton Avenue and Toboggan Trail.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Kinnelon, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Chapter 84-27A Twenty-five miles per hour, shall add:
(65) Fayson Lakes Road, between Boonton Avenue and Toboggan Trail.

Chapter 84-27C Thirty-five miles per hour, (1) Fayson Lakes Road shall now read:
Fayson Lakes Road, between Kinnelon Road and Toboggan Trail.



If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or federal or state agency of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES. Ordinances, resolutions, and regulations or parts of ordinances, resolutions, and regulations inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.


